

# Dual Enrollment



## What is it?

• Enables high school students to take college level courses at a reduced rate to earn college *AND* high school credits while still in high school.



# How does it work?

- Release time to take classes at college
- Approval from school. Students and parents meet with High School Counselor
- Typically Mod for Mod
- Mornings/Afternoons
- Courses at MVHS are not offered five days a week so students can go to media on non-class days or come in late/leave early depending on schedule
- Classes at Carroll sometimes start a week prior to classes at CCPS, make sure you pay attention to start dates

# What should I consider?

- AP and other courses needed

#### Course load

- High School
- College

### Extra/Co-curricular activities (especially sports)

• Eligibility is impacted by final grade in course. Quarter grades are not issued.

# What's the difference from AP?

### **Advanced Placement**

- High Stakes Test
- Acceptable scores at colleges vary
- Stay at school

### **Dual Enrollment**

- 15 week college course
- Transferrable credit with C+
- Check out ARTSYS for transfer information: <u>ARTSYS MD (usmd.edu)</u>
- Need transportation to college
- Weighted same as AP on HS transcript
- Establish a college transcript (impact)

Dual Discount = 25% off (approximate)


3 credits = \$383.40 / Dual @ CCPS = \$275.4! Merit based scholarships are available for high school students
