



Dual Enrollment



What is it?

- Enables high school students to take college level courses at a reduced rate to earn college *AND* high school credits while still in high school.



How does it work?

- Release time to take classes at college
- Approval from school. Students and parents meet with High School Counselor
- Typically Mod for Mod
- Mornings/Afternoons
- Courses at MVHS are not offered five days a week so students can go to media on non-class days or come in late/leave early depending on schedule
- Classes at Carroll sometimes start a week prior to classes at CCPS, make sure you pay attention to start dates

- Eligibility is impacted by final grade in course. Quarter grades are not issued.

- High Stakes Test
- Acceptable scores at colleges vary
- Stay at school

Dual Enrollment

- 15 week college course
- Transferrable credit with C+

- Need transportation to college
- Weighted same as AP on HS transcript
- Establish a college transcript (impact)

The student may earn .5 high school credit for dual enrollment college courses (3-4 credits) at the 100 level and above. The student must request credit and grade to be reflected on the high school transcript before the end of the semester in which he/she is enrolled. The course and final grade will be calculated in the GPA according to the weighted grades for AP/ transcript credit and reflected on the high school transcript. All other dual enrollment courses will receive P/F (Pass/Fail) elective credit.

Part III: Student and Parent Signatures

My signature below verifies that I have met the requirements and understand that it is my responsibility to contact the school office on a regular basis to find out about senior activities and deadlines. Further, I am aware that transportation for these experiences, in all cases, shall be the responsibility of the student/parent/legal guardian. What if my student needs accommodations?

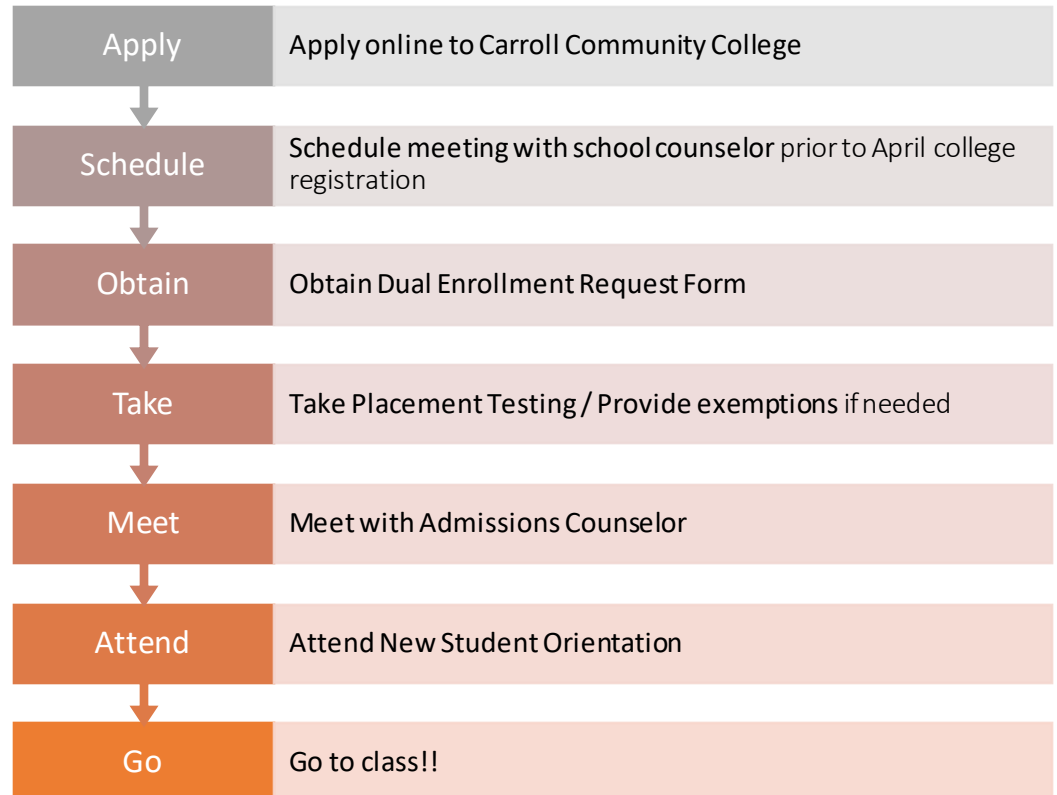
Your student should reach out to the office of ADA support at Carroll by calling 410-386-8329.
